APPLICATION

Exchange / Visiting student tuition fees

- A. Exchange Student:** From Partner Universities(currently enrolled) will not be charged any tuition fees.
- B. Visiting Student:** From universities (currently enrolled) will be charged the INU tuition fee
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Nomination Procedure

The international office of the home university:

1. Obtain the User ID and Password for each university.
: Please submit [the Form \(Click\)](#) or send an email (inbound@inu.ac.kr) to request the ID and Password for the Online Nomination Link.
2. The International Office of INU will send the University's ID and Password to the International Office of your home university after submitting [the Form \(Click\)](#).
3. Access the [Online Nomination LINK](#) and complete the Nomination application for each student.

Application Procedure

Nominated students:

1. Submit the required application documents ([Link](#)) through the [Online Application LINK](#) during the application period.
(Please prepare the application documents in advance, just in case obtaining certain documents takes time.)
 2. INU screens the application documents and issues a certificate of admission.
 3. Students can download the certificate of admission and other materials(Acceptance Package) in the [Online Application LINK](#) to apply for a visa.

ACADEMIC

Courses

Information about courses changes every semester, so please check our website regularly.

- Major students have the first opportunity to register for their major courses during the Course Registration Period.
- All students register for courses through the online course registration system at the same time, so, it may be competitive to get a spot in some courses.
(We recommend that students discuss with the Coordinator at their home university to prepare several options in advance for registration.)
- **The English-taught courses List** will be confirmed for next semester in early February / August. Please refer to the course list from the previous corresponding semester. ([2025/26 course list: Link](#))

Korean Language Courses

- Conducted by the Department of Korean Language and Literature
- Only Undergraduate / Credits given
- We offer free Korean language courses to exchange students.
- The Korean-level test must be taken before the semester.

Credit Load

- All exchange students have to take at least one class.
 - 1) Undergraduate students are allowed to take up to 18 credits per semester.
 - 2) Graduate students are allowed to take up to 9 credits per semester and not allowed to take Undergraduate courses.
- Students can take courses across all majors, with the exception of courses that are restricted to exchange students.
- Most classes are 3 hours per week, which means three credits per class. (1 credit = 15 class hours)

VISA INFORMATION

1. VISA Requirements

- **Visa Types:** D-2-6 (Exchange) or D-2-8 (Visiting)
- **How to Apply:** Submit your Certificate of Admission (issued by Incheon National University) to your local Korean Embassy.
- **Critical Warning:** Do not leave Korea until you receive your Residence Card (RC). Student visas are single-entry; exiting before the RC will cancel your visa immediately.

2. Residency Registration

- **Deadline:** Within 90 days of arrival.
- **Process:** You must visit the Immigration Office to register for your RC.
- **Support:** Detailed guidance will be provided during the International Students Orientation.

HEALTH INSURANCE

1) National Health Insurance (NHIS)

All international students will be automatically enrolled in the National Health Insurance from the date of the alien registration card. (Approx. Monthly Cost. 75,000 KRW)

Before that, your international health insurance should cover all medical costs. Students have to subscribe in advance to personal insurance valid for 2 to 3 months from the moment of arrival to Korea.

2) Private International Insurance for the gap in NHIS

Purchasing Private International Insurance is Mandatory because of the gap in NHIS's effect.

This private insurance covers international students' accidents and sicknesses until the National Health Insurance(NHIS) takes effect.

How to purchase:

- You can purchase from your home country OR from a Korean private company; we will provide information.

The students will be responsible for addressing their travel abroad needs. Please check the details on our website, [Health Insurance](#).

1. Utilities and Meal

- Meals are not included
- Utility fees and facility deposit are included
- Blankets and pillows are not provided in a room, so you should purchase them individually.

2. Tuberculosis test & Measles Vaccination

- Students must submit the **Tuberculosis test result** (Only an X-ray with a doctor's note, only two month before the check-in date is valid.) and a **Certificate of Measles Vaccination** (at least once) on move-in day. Without the document, you are not allowed to check in. (The TB test should be taken within two months before the check-in date.)

3. Extensions

- Extensions are possible during vacations; the International Office will announce detailed information before the semester ends. The details are subject to change, and we will inform you as soon as we have. For more information, please refer to the [link](#)
- Due to the capacity of the on-campus dormitory, depending on the number of exchange students, there will also be an option for off-campus housing.

Off-Campus Housing

If you wish to live off campus, you need to obtain permission from your home university.

You may stay at the Off-Campus Residence that we informed you about(in December/June), or you can choose to find your own accommodation.

It is a group of INU students that organizes various cultural activities for international students.

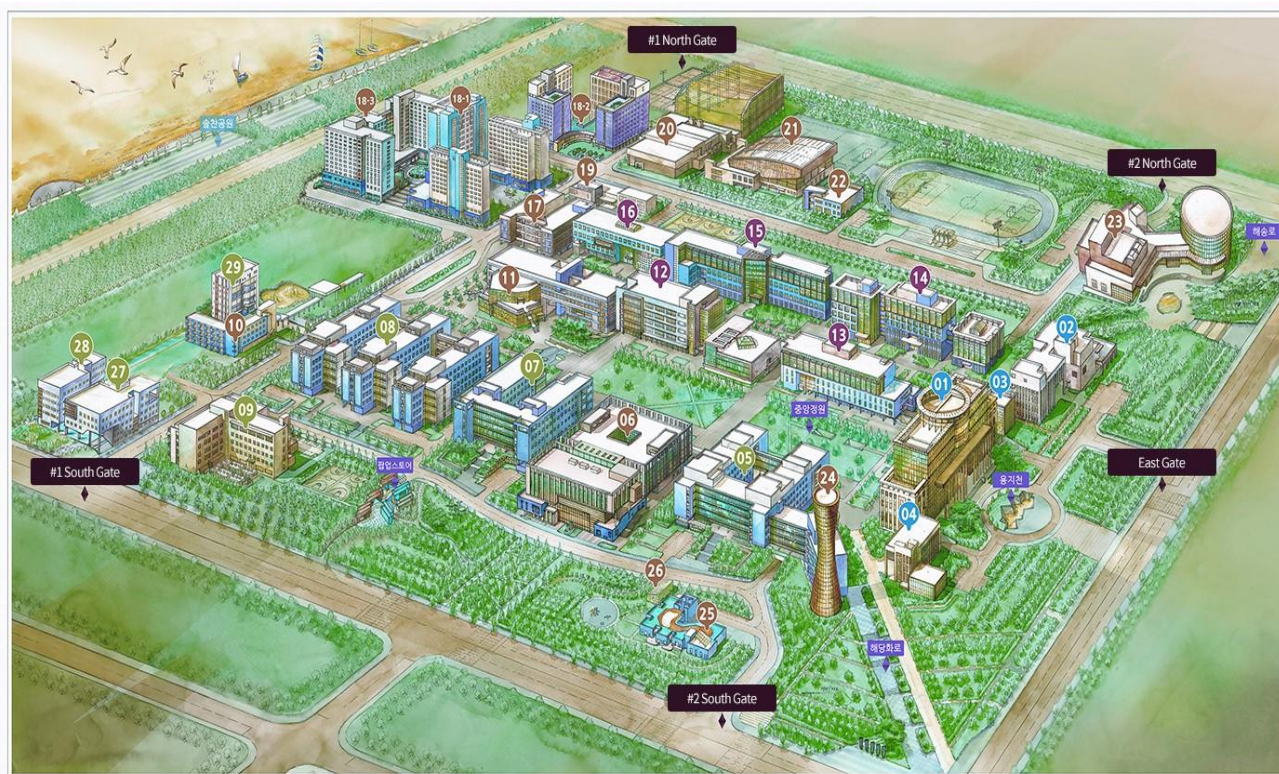
It is an active student group to help you adjust smoothly to campus life and the culture of Korea.
